2010 Clay Target Tournament

The Blue Ridge Foothills District of the Water Environment Association of SC will be returning to the River Bend's Sportsman's Resort for its next meeting on Tuesday, September 21th. The meeting activities start early this year at noon "*rain or shine*" at the River Bend's Sportsman's Resort in Fingerville, in northern Spartanburg County. This is the sixth time the WEASC will meet at the very popular River Bend Resort and the 11th time the Blue Ridge Foothills District has been host for a Clay Target Shoot. The shoot format this year is as follows: One round of Sporting Clays consisting of 110 targets. The shooter has the shotgun at the ready, unmounted, and stock below the elbow until the target is visible. Shooting menus will be posted for each station. Past Champions will be given a handicap!

Groups of 4 will form a squad and are encouraged to shoot together. Two squads will shoot the course together; taking turns scoring and pulling targets for each other.

Awards will be given for Sporting Clays high score, Runner-Up and Third Place. The Annie Oakley Award will again be presented to the lady shooting the highest score. (*One award only per shooter*). Class awards will also be presented.

Other prizes will also be awarded at the dinner meeting. The Social Hour and open bar will begin at 6pm and the evening meal of Prime Rib or Chicken with desert prepared by River Bend's chef. As has become our custom, awards will be presented to the winners of these events during the evening dinner.

Once again, the "**WEASC Blue Ridge District Clay Target Challenge Trophy**" will also be up for grabs to the agency that enters the most shooters in the tournament. This trophy is designed to encourage participation and sportsmanship, and is not based on score.

The "**Two Man Team**" award will be presented. This crystal trophy is similar to the WEASC Blue Ridge District Clay Target Challenge Trophy. It will be presented to the Two Man Team recording the high combined score out of 220 targets. To qualify for this award, the two team shooters must be from the same agency or district.
